

Rules and Regulations

This card will be issued after each grading period and must be turned into the Guidance Office by Thursday during the week following the end of each grading period.

Effort grades are given out by each academic teacher on a scale of 4 to 0:

- 4 = Above and beyond what is expected
- 3 = Usually
- 2 = Sometimes
- 1 = Rarely
- 0 = Never

These grades are based on:

1. Respect for all people Quality of work reflects student's best effort
 Respect for all school facilities Appropriate participation
 Responsibility Cooperativeness
 Prepared for and on time to class Good attendance (following policy)
2. Included in each teacher's effort grade is any **observable behavior in the halls, cafeteria, bus or other areas of the school or property.**
3. Study hall teachers will not give effort grades. Academic teachers will issue an effort grade in each academic subject.
4. The effort grade average will be computed by the Guidance Office. A student will be eligible to receive a green card with a 3.45 average or above for only the quarterly grading period following this average. This card will be re-issued for each grading period. A student may not receive a duplicate card if he loses his card. All privileges are suspended for two weeks for those losing cards. If the student does not turn in their Green Card when required at the end of each marking period then the student will lose privileges for one quarter.
5. A committee comprised of Administration, Guidance Counselor, Attendance Officer and faculty will review eligible students to determine who will receive a Green Card.

Regulations for Green Card Holders:

1. Students must go to only designated areas: Cafeteria, library conference room, guidance hallway, and end of hallway near room 11 on main floor, or outside at entranceway near sawhorses.
2. Students must report to study halls and homerooms for attendance and/or announcements and sign out to a particular location. Study hall teachers must be kept informed if student moves to a different location.
3. Students may not disturb any classes, including gym, inside and outside of the school building. No food or drink is allowed in hallways or rooms.
4. Students who have Green Cards may not be released from academic subjects, only study halls.
5. This policy will be reviewed periodically.
6. Green Cards will be revoked for noncompliance of rules in that grading period.
7. Green Card privileges are suspended for 1 week before midterms and finals.
